5.	Read <b>V6-7</b> . As Abraham and Isaac walked up the mountain, what question did Isaac ask, and what emotions could he have been feeling?
3.	a) What impresses you about Abraham's response to Isaac (V8)?

b) Why do you think Abraham was trusting God to **provide**? (See **Hebrews 11:17-19**)

- 7. Describe the scene and possible emotions of Abraham as he continued to obey God in **V9-10**.
- 8. a) In your own words, what did God tell Abraham in **V11-12**?
  - b) How did Abraham's actions demonstrate that he feared God?
- 9. Given that Abraham had an older son, Ishmael, why do you think God referred to Isaac as Abraham's "only son"? (V2, V12)
- 10. How did God **provide** for Abraham and Isaac in **V13**?
- 11. In **V14** what did Abraham named the mountain? And what could this saying mean to you in your own life?
