1. What must Abram do according to ch. 12:1? How would you respond today to this command?
2. Name the major parts to the promise of God in ch. 12:2-3?
3. In this promise it states that if Abram obeyed God, Abram would be a blessing to others. Have you ever experienced being a blessing to others as a direct result of your obedience to God? Share this with your group?
4. Who went with Abram? What was the name of the land to which he traveled? To where did Abram travel first?
5. When Abram arrived, to whom did God promise this land? Give verse. Are you willing to obey God for your future offspring? Give an example of a way you are living obedient to God now in order to bring promise for your offspring?

6. Even though Abram had no offspring at this time, how did Abram show the Lord he planned to obey? Give the verse.
  
7. When trouble hit through the famine, what did Abram do? Was this in obedience or not? Tell why?
  
8. In ch. 12:10-20, a segment of Abram's life following God is displayed.
  - a) Where did Abram sin in this scene?
  
  - b) Who suffered when Abram sinned?
  
  - c) When you sin, do you think others are also effected? Share a situation that illustrates this from your own life.
  
9. When Abram returned to the land of Canaan, where did he go and what did he do? What do you think "called on the name of the Lord" means?
