1. What brought trouble between Abram's and Lot's herdsmen? Who was the rightful owner here?
2. Who offered a solution to the problem? What was the solution?
3. Abram was the man to whom God had promised the blessings and the land. Why do you think Abram let Lot choose first for his pick of the land? Do you think Abram was wise or foolish?
4. Abram appears to have given up his "rights" in order to bring peace into a difficult circumstance. Have you ever done this? Share with your group and what were the results?
5. Where did Lot choose to live and why did he choose this area? Are there any familiar names in the area Lot chose that indicate future problems for Lot?

6. When you are going to choose a place to live or inhabit, name the reasons you pick a certain place over another? Be honest!

7. In ch. 13:14-17, God addresses Abram about his land. What conclusions can you draw about Abram's decision based upon God's words to Abram?

8. To what town did Abram move and what was the first thing he did when he arrived? What do you think this meant spiritually?

9. How often do you build an altar to the Lord? Explain what your altar entails? Is it a physical altar or a spiritual altar? How would you describe this altar to your group?
