2. Name the different purposes of the lights in the sky in vs. 14-18.

4. In vs. 11-24 note how many times it states “according to their own kind”. Why do you think this phrase is important in the context of today’s philosophy about the origin of life?
5. What does it mean to see that something is “good” stated many times in these verses?
6. What did God create and command in all living creatures to assure life continued?
