3. How do you personally set aside a time to rest and a time to have as holy during your week?
4. How was the earth watered in these ancient, beginning days? Give the verse.
5. How does the creation of man mentioned in Genesis 2:7 differ from the account in ch. 1:26-27?
6. Based on Genesis 2:10-14, in what part of the world was the Garden of Eden located?
7. What was God's only restriction in the entire garden for Adam regarding eating?
