

Questions for Genesis 3:1-24

Please answer these questions without any source except your Bible (no commentary, Bible margin notes, etc.)

Pray before you do the questions and ask God to open your mind, soul and spirit to His teaching through His Word.

Think about these questions. They are designed to expand your knowledge of God and His Word.

Have fun! Enjoy your time with God and His Word.

1. Look back at Genesis 2:16-17. What was God's exact command? To whom was the command given?
2. Look at Gen. 3:1. What did the serpent say God's command was? Was this accurate? Explain your answer. To whom was the serpent speaking in vs. 1?
3. What was distorted and who did the distorting? Think! Who do you think is doing the speaking through the serpent? Where did he come from? Was he good or evil and why? You may use other passages from Scripture to help form an answer.
4. Where are you distorting God's Word? Where are you listening to a lie about God's teaching or His goodness? Be honest!
5. In vs. 6-7, what were the results of believing distortions? Were the results what the serpent had promised or what Adam and Eve had hoped for?
6. Read Romans 5:12-13. Why do you think it says sin entered through one man when it was Eve who took the first bite?

7. Name the ways God did not abandon Adam and Eve despite their sin. Use Genesis 3:8-24 for your answer.

8. Name the consequences to this entry of sin to:

a) the serpent

b) the woman

c) the man.

(Put the consequences in your own words – not just repeating the verses.)

9. Can you see these consequences in your own life? Share how.
