1. How many months did the flood last according to Genesis 7:24 and 8:3?
2. What two birds did Noah send out from the ark and what were the results of these send-offs? What did Noah learn from this?
3. God told Noah to come out of the ark in 8:16. Do you think this was an easy or hard command to follow and why? What is a command of God's that has been hard for you? Easy for you? Did you obey these commands?
4. What is the first thing Noah did when he came out of the ark?
5. What promise or promises did God make to Noah when He saw Noah's sacrifice?
6. What new food were the survivors of the flood now allowed to eat? What restriction were they given with this new addition? Why according to God were they given this restriction?

7. Why did God say a man or animal must die for killing a man?

8. What sign did God give Noah regarding God's covenant with him? Name the promise in the covenant and who was the covenant with?

9. Name the sons of Noah and explain why they are important. Explain the sins mentioned in 9:20-23 and how Noah handled this in vs. 24-27. What conclusions about Noah and his sons do you draw from this?

10. If you're in or aware of a situation like question nine describes, what is your role according to the following verses? (Read Proverbs 10:12; 17:9 and 21:23; James 3:9-12). Be honest and state how you handle delicate or juicy circumstances?
