1. Read ch. 10:1-32. Are there any names of descendants that give indication of what type of people they were? Are there any town's names that trigger some information you already know about them? Are there any names that seem unique and why?
2. Ch. 10 is a description of the known world in the years after the flood. In ch. 11 what did the entire world have in common and where were they settled?
3. What was the purpose of the tower the men planned on building in this city in Ch. 11:3-4? Do you think this was God's plan for Noah and his descendants? Why? See Gen. 9:1 and 9:7 to help you with your answer.
4. What was the Lord's reaction to this tower?
5. What did the Lord do to stop this building?
