As Simple As “A–B–C–C–B–A”

I. A Holy God; A Guilty Nation; A Teachable King:

2 Samuel 21:1-14

Principle: God withholds his blessings in our lives if we fail to address the sin in our hearts. If your heart is teachable and your eyes are open, God will use a variety of circumstances and people to reveal areas of unrecognized sin in your life.

II. An Exhausted King: 2 Samuel 21:15-22

Principle: When we are exhausted, the Lord will raise up others who are more equipped to fight the giants who keep on coming.

III. A Saving God, A Rescued King: 2 Samuel 22

Principle: When we cry out to God, He hears us; He reaches down and rescues us simply because He delights in us.
