## Lesson 6: Exodus 7–10

October 17, 2007

- I. Mezzo-piano plagues bring inconvenience and irritation: Exodus 7:1-8:19 **Principle:** God has authority over any gods (with a little g) in one's life.
- II. Mezzo-forte plagues of destruction are directed at Egypt only: Exodus 8:20–9:12 **Principles:** 
  - -A person hardens her heart when she deliberately and willfully chooses to go against God.
  - -God has mercy on whom He wills, and whom He wills He hardens.
- III. Plagues crescendo towards the point of no return: Exodus 9:13–10:29

  Principle: God will use one's obedience or one's disobedience to reveal Himself and His power to others.

Notes:
