b) What are the people's reactions according to Jesus?  
  
c) What are the characteristics Jesus would publicly state about you? Name as many as you know.
  
4. a) Why did Jesus denounce the cities of Korazin, Bethsaida and Capernaum?  
  
b) In what similar ways could Jesus denounce you?
  
5. a) Explain the spiritual meaning of verse 25.

b) Why is Jesus teaching this?

6. Explain the major theological truths Jesus was teaching in verse 27.

7. a) According to verse 28, who are commanded to come to Jesus?

b) What does Jesus promise to give those who come to Him?

8. a) Where or to whom do you go when you are weary and burdened? Be honest.

b) What would rest look like to you?

9. a) Why do you **think** Jesus' yoke is easy and His burden is light?

b) If you believed this, would you go to Jesus sooner? State why or why not.
