# Lesson 24: Matthew 21:18-22:14

I. The Robes of Pretense: Matthew 21:18–22

**Principle:** True Faith is more than just pretend or professing faith.

II. The Robes of Rebellion: Matthew 21:23–32

**Principle:** The Truth of Jesus demands a decision of belief or non-belief.

III. The Robes of Rejection: Matthew 21:33–46

**Principle:** If you reject Jesus as Savior—you will face Him as Judge.

IV. The Robes of Righteousness: Matthew 22:1–14

**Principle:** All who follow Jesus must be robed in His righteousness.

#### Psalm 132:16

I will clothe her priests with salvation, and her saints will ever sing for joy.

## Isaiah 61:10

I delight greatly in the LORD;

my soul rejoices in my God.

For he has clothed me with garments of salvation

and arrayed me in a robe of righteousness,

as a bridegroom adorns his head like a priest,

and as a bride adorns herself with her jewels.

#### Zechariah 3:3-5

<sup>3</sup> Now Joshua was dressed in filthy clothes as he stood before the angel. <sup>4</sup> The angel said to those who were standing before him, "Take off his filthy clothes." Then he said to Joshua, "See, I have taken away your sin, and I will put rich garments on you."

<sup>5</sup> Then I said, "Put a clean turban on his head." So they put a clean turban on his head and clothed him, while the angel of the LORD stood by.

### Revelation 3:4-5

<sup>4</sup> Yet you have a few people in Sardis who have not soiled their clothes. They will walk with me, dressed in white, for they are worthy. <sup>5</sup> He who overcomes will, like them, be dressed in white. I will never blot out his name from the book of life, but will acknowledge his name before my Father and his angels.

#### Revelation 19:7-8

<sup>7</sup>Let us rejoice and be glad and give him glory!

For the wedding of the Lamb has come, and his bride has made herself ready.

<sup>8</sup> Fine linen, bright and clean, was given her to wear." (Fine linen stands for the righteous acts of the saints.)
