 - c) What is the "authority" for that instruction in both cases?
- 9. What instruction from God's Word do you resist or wrestle with, and how does **V8** convict or compel you?

- 11. Summarize the definition of sexual immorality given in **V4-6**.
- 12. What are some of the possible sexual sins implied in **V6** as well as the consequences?

14. According to **V9-10**, why didn't the authors need to instruct the Thessalonians?

15. Instead of instruct, what do the authors "urge" the Thessalonians to do in V10?

16. Share an example from your own life of how you've been "taught by God" to love others.

17. Rewrite the instruction from **V11** in your own words.

18. According to **V12**, what is the purpose of this "ambition"? Why?

19. Write a prayer based on this week's passage.
