WBS Kids Lesson #19
Colossians 1:16c

HOOK: Think about the last time you played with Play-Doh. (Maybe it was today!) Did you make some colorful balls of dough? Maybe you flattened some dough and used a cookie cutter to make shapes. As you worked with the dough, you created. You were a creator! You made all kinds of new things out of Play-Doh.

BOOK: When we open our Bible, we read in Colossians about the Son of God, Jesus. We read, “**all things have been created through Him and for Him.**” Jesus is the Creator of all things! That’s no small thing. Jesus is *that* powerful and *that* creative!

LOOK: Look around you—everything you see was created through Jesus and for Jesus, the Son of God. He created you. He created me. He created the sun, moon, and stars. He even created the ingredients used to make Play-Doh!

TOOK: Jesus wants you to remember that He created you...that He created everything! Think about every person and every thing that makes you smile. Jesus is the amazing Creator of all those people and things! When you go home today take notice of some of the things around you that God created like your pet, the beautiful trees outside, the warm sunshine, your favorite fruit...and tell Him, “Thank You, Jesus!”
