

I Want to Know You...The Attributes of God

#06--God is Infinite

HOOK: *Ask one of the kids to stand next to you or against the wall facing the other children. With your hand, "mark" how tall the child is. Say something like, "Wow! You are really tall!" Then, ask another child how old he/she is. Say, "You're really growing up!" Next, choose another child and ask them to tell you something special they know how to do. Say, "How wonderful that you know how to _____!"*

BOOK: Each of you are growing taller, getting older, becoming smarter and you are learning how to do some wonderful things! Did you know, though, that you will only become just so tall and you will have just so many birthdays and you and I can only do and know just so many things? We can't know and do everything. But, our God is not like us. He is INFINITE which means He has no limits. He can't be measured. The Bible says He fills heaven and earth! He isn't a certain size or a certain age--He has always been and always will be. And, there is nothing He cannot do--His power has no limits! Isn't that amazing? The Bible says, **"How great is God--beyond our understanding! The number of His years is past finding out."** God is so great that we cannot fully understand how great He is! And, we can't figure out how old He is because He has always been!

LOOK: Let's say today's attribute together: INFINITE. God is infinite. Boys and girls, aren't you glad that our God is so great that we can't measure Him with a tape measure or a scale and He can't be contained in a box? We can't look Him up on the Internet and know everything there is to know about Him because He is beyond our complete knowledge! He is much greater than that!

TOOK: I have a special assignment for you. Sometime today I want you to take a minute and look up at the sky and the clouds (don't stare at the sun because it will hurt your eyes!). Ask your mom or dad to join you. Maybe you can lie down in the grass and look up and think about how big the sky is. Then, remember that God is even bigger. He is greater. He is more beautiful. He has no limits. He is infinite!

Bible Verse: **"How great is God--beyond our understanding! The number of His years is past finding out." Job 36:26**

Prayer: **"Dear Lord, how amazing You are! Thank You that even though You are beyond our understanding, You still help us to know You because You love us. Amen."**
