

I Want to Know You...The Attributes of God
#18--God is Omnipresent

HOOK: Do any of you sleep with a teddy bear or some other kind of stuffed animal? Some kids like to sleep with a stuffed animal because it helps them feel safe and less alone when they go to bed. But guess what? The truth is you are never really alone because God Himself is always with you! Knowing that should comfort you way more than a teddy bear!

BOOK: Today our Attribute of God is: OMNIPRESENT. This means that God is everywhere at the same time. We cannot see or touch Him, but the Bible tells us that He is always right where we are...no matter where we are! God wants that truth to soak in and comfort and strengthen us. He says: “**Do not fear, for I am with you; do not be dismayed [or discouraged] for I am your God. I will strengthen you and help you; I will uphold you with my righteous right hand.**” (Isaiah 40:11) What an amazing promise!

LOOK: Hmm...I wonder *when* exactly God is with us? In the morning? At night when it's time to go to sleep? Do you think He's only with us when we are being good? Or is He with us when we're not being very nice or having a bad day? The Bible tells us that our Omnipresent God is with us at ALL times. God's Word says, “**...He will never leave you...**” (Deut. 31:6) and that He is “**...always ready to help in times of trouble.**” (Ps. 46:1 NLT) That means that morning, noon and night, during good days and not-so-good days God is with us! God doesn't take a vacation. He's never late in coming. He is always there...with us!

TOOK: Use your imaginations with me right now and close your eyes. Picture yourself walking along with God, hand-in-hand, talking to Him. Don't you feel safe and happy knowing that God loves you, hears you and is right there by your side? Now, open your eyes. Boys and girls, the truth is God really is always with you and He loves you so much!

Here's what I want you to do tonight when you're in bed waiting to fall asleep: Close your eyes and remember that God is OMNIPRESENT. He is everywhere at the same time which means He is right where you are. Picture yourself holding His hand...

Bible Verse: “Do not fear, for I am with you...I am Your God.” Isaiah 41:10a

Prayer: “Dear Lord, how amazing to know that You are everywhere at all times! Thank You for being with us and helping us every minute of every day. Amen.”

parent/child
activity

Illustrate God's omnipresence for your child. Sit close to him (or her) on the couch and hold hands or put your arm around him. Say something like: "See how close I am to you? I am right beside you, but I can't always be right here. Sometimes I need to be in the other room or at work or you're outside playing and I'm inside." Then, explain that God, who is omnipresent, is always with him--every minute of every day. No matter where he is, God is there.
