

It's a job to be Job—Kids' Lesson #24
Job 42:1-6, Genesis 16:13, Psalm 139:1-6

Hook: I know this may seem a little silly, but I want you to stand up and sit back down. Now, without saying a word, I want you to think of something in your mind, but don't tell me or anyone what you thought about. Did you know that just now, as we stood up and sat down, God saw our every move? And, God knows what each of us was thinking? Wow! He can do all things which means He knows everything.

Book: Now let's switch gears and think about last week when our friend Job asked God, *Do you even know what you're doing?* God reminded Job that He is all-powerful and full of majesty. God is King. Job is sorry for doubting and questioning the Lord. He says, "I'm sorry for what I said about You." And, "I know You can do anything and no one can stop You." Job begins to remember how great and wonderful God is. He tells God he wishes he could take back what he said. Job was truly sorry.

Look: The Bible says, "**You are the God who sees me**" (Genesis 16:13). God knows everything about us. He knows when we stand up and when we sit back down. He knows our thoughts. He sees us no matter where we go. He knows what we're going to say even before we say it. He created us after all! The Bible says: "**You are all around me; behind me and in front of me. You hold me safe in Your hand. I'm amazed at how well You know me, it's more that I can understand**" (Psalm 139:5-6 NIRV).

Took: It sure is exciting and comforting to think about God's power and how He knows us inside and out. This week, when you brush your teeth, think, "God sees me." When you're lying quietly in your bed, think, "God knows what I am thinking. He is all around me. He sees me. He loves me." Let's remember how powerful and wonderful God is so we will not doubt God's greatness and love for us.

Prayer: "Thank You God for seeing us and knowing us. Help us to not doubt Your power and goodness. Amen."

Bible Verse: "I know You can do all things..." (Job 42:2a)
