

LESSON 14 GENESIS 21-22

- 1. What truth, verse, or insight from last week's study of **Genesis 18-20** was meaningful to you and why?
- 2. Pray and ask God to give you a fresh view of His care and provision as you read Genesis 21-22.
- 3. a) Read **Genesis 21:1-7**. How is Sarah's laughter in **V6** different from the reason she laughed before God's promise to her was fulfilled (read **18:9-15** to refresh your memory)?
 - b) Is there a promise in the Bible that causes you to laugh? Does your laughter come from disbelief, genuine hope, or the joy of a promise fulfilled? (Cite the verse reference of the promise if possible.)
- 4. a) Abraham, Hagar and Ishmael are going through great challenges as seen in **Genesis 21:8-21.** In your view, summarize why each one is distressed.
 - Abraham
 - Hagar
 - Ishmael

b) What attributes of God do you recognize as He interacts with each of these people?

- 5. The following verses talk about distress and trouble. Rewrite each one as a personal prayer:
 - Psalm 20:1
 - Psalm 50:15
 - 2 Samuel 22:7
- 6. a) Summarize what takes place in V22-34 of Genesis 21.
 - b) What do you find interesting about Abimelek's visit to make a treaty with Abraham (especially in light of their interaction in **Chapter 20**)?
- 7. Why might Abraham's actions in **21:33 & 34**, after Abimelek departs, be significant? Identify the ways that you see God providing for Abraham in this passage.
- 8. a) In **Genesis 22** God tests Abraham in a profoundly difficult way, telling him to sacrifice Isaac. What words or phrases in **V1-10** showcase Abraham's full obedience?
 - b) Write down a specific time when you knew God was testing you, perhaps by telling you to do something difficult. Did you choose to obey Him fully? What was the outcome?
- 9. a) According to **V13-23**, how did God provide for Abraham at the moment of his need (before he could slay Isaac), and how does God provide for him and his descendants in the future?

- b) What words or phrases stand out to you as God's unwavering promise of provision for Abraham, specifically in **V16 & 17**? How might this have boosted his faith?
- 10. a) In **Genesis 22:8**, Abraham's confidence in God is summed up in four words: *"God Himself will provide..."* As you studied **Genesis 21-22**, how were you convicted to allow a fresh confidence in God's provision *"take ROOT"* regarding a situation in your life?
 - b) Read **Hebrews 11:17-19** together with **James 2:21-22**. What inspires you in your own faith journey as you see how Abraham's faith became more deeply **ROOTED1**`?

"GOSPEL GLIMPSES": Throughout the Book of Genesis, we will see previews of Jesus, and a foreshadowing of the Gospel (The Salvation Story).

- 1. There are a number of Gospel Glimpses found in **Genesis 22.** In **V2**, **12**, **16**, what phrase is repeated, and what are the similarities regarding God's Son and Abraham's? (See also John 3:16)
- 2. How is the wood placed on Isaac (Genesis 22:6) a foreshadowing of Jesus in John 19:17?
- 3. Just as Isaac appears to have cooperated fully with his father, what does **Matthew 26:39** reveal about Jesus' obedience to His Father to be a sacrifice for the sins of the world?
- 4. Compare and contrast **Genesis 22:13** with **John 1:29** (see also **Romans 3:25**) as you look for Gospel Glimpses in this story.
- 5. a) Write out the Suggested Memory Verse: Genesis 22:14
 - b) Write a prayer of praise and thanksgiving for how God provides for you in the various areas of your life (physical, emotional, spiritual, etc.
