5. In what ways have you seen or faced a “countermovement away from the reality of the resurrection” today?
6. What does it mean to “make disciples?” What does this look like in your own life?
7. In what ways does Jesus' promise to be with us always, even to the end of the age, give us hope?
8. How did God speak to you through the message this week and how will you apply that?

1. In verses 1-10, list the terms or images that relate that are similar to the Creation story.
2. Why do you think Matthew used creation-type language in reacting the Resurrection?
3. What is the response of the guards and religious leaders to Resurrection? What stands out to you from their response?
4. Jesus can do or command anything - and He commands His disciples to go. How does this relate to Easter and the Resurrection movement?
5. Who are the intended recipients of this commission?
6. How effective are we, as a church, at "go"?
7. What situations are you in right now that need to experience the New World of Resurrection?

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
