

SUGGESTED MEMORY VERSES- GENESIS

Lesson 1: Genesis 1:27

So God created mankind in His own image, in the image of God He created them; male and female He created them.

Lesson 2: Genesis 2:7

Then the LORD God formed a man from the dust of the ground and breathed into his nostrils the breath of life, and the man became a living being.

Lesson 3: 1 Corinthians 15:22

For as in Adam all die, so in Christ all will be made alive.

Lesson 4: Genesis 4:7

If you do what is right, will you not be accepted? But if you do not do what is right, sin is crouching at your door; it desires to have you, but you must rule over it."

Lesson 5: Genesis 6:8

But Noah found favor in the eyes of the LORD.

Lesson 6: Genesis 6:9

This is the account of Noah and his family. Noah was a righteous man, blameless among the people of his time, and he walked faithfully with God.

Lesson 7: Genesis 9:16

Whenever the rainbow appears in the clouds, I will see it and remember the everlasting covenant between God and all living creatures of every kind on the earth."

Lesson 8: 1 John 2:16 or Proverbs 16:9

For everything in the world—the lust of the flesh, the lust of the eyes, and the pride of life—comes not from the Father but from the world.

In their hearts humans plan their course, but the LORD establishes their steps.

Lesson 9: Hebrews 11:8 or Galatians 3:9

By faith Abraham, when called to go to a place he would later receive as his inheritance, obeyed and went, even though he did not know where he was going.

So those who rely on faith are blessed along with Abraham, the man of faith.

Lesson 10: Ephesians 4:3 or Hebrews 5:9b-10

Make every effort to keep the unity of the Spirit through the bond of peace.

Hebrews 5:9b-10

He became the source of eternal salvation for all who obey Him ¹⁰ and was designated by God to be high priest in the order of Melchizedek.

Lesson 11: Genesis 15:6

Abram believed the LORD, and he credited it to him as righteousness.

Lesson 12: Genesis 16:13 or 17:7

She gave this name to the LORD who spoke to her: "You are the God who sees me," for she said, "I have now seen the One who sees me."

I will establish my covenant as an everlasting covenant between Me and you and your descendants after you for the generations to come, to be your God and the God of your descendants after you.

Lesson 13: Genesis 18:14a

Is anything too hard for the LORD?

Lesson 14: Genesis 22:14

So Abraham called that place The LORD Will Provide. And to this day it is said, "On the mountain of the LORD it will be provided."

Lesson 15: Genesis 24:12 or Romans 8:28

Then he prayed, "LORD, God of my master Abraham, make me successful today, and show kindness to my master Abraham.

And we know that in all things God works for the good of those who love Him, who have been called according to His purpose.

Lesson 16: Genesis 26:24 or Job 42:2

That night the LORD appeared to him and said, "I am the God of your father Abraham. Do not be afraid, for I am with you; I will bless you and will increase the number of your descendants for the sake of my servant Abraham."

I know that You can do all things; no purpose of Yours can be thwarted.

Lesson 17: Genesis 28:15

I am with you and will watch over you wherever you go, and I will bring you back to this land. I will not leave you until I have done what I have promised you."

Lesson 18: John 10:11

I am the good shepherd. The Good Shepherd lays down His life for the sheep.

Lesson 19: Colossians 1:21-22 or Genesis 32:10a

Once you were alienated from God and were enemies in your minds because of your evil behavior. ²² But now He has reconciled you by Christ's physical body through death to present you holy in His sight, without blemish and free from accusation—

I am unworthy of all the kindness and faithfulness You have shown your servant.

Lesson 20: Genesis 35:2 or Romans 2:4

So Jacob said to his household and to all who were with him, "Get rid of the foreign gods you have with you, and purify yourselves and change your clothes.

Or do you show contempt for the riches of His kindness, forbearance and patience, not realizing that God's kindness is intended to lead you to repentance?

Lesson 21: Romans 5:3-5

Not only so, but we also glory in our sufferings, because we know that suffering produces perseverance; ⁴ perseverance, character; and character, hope. ⁵ And hope does not put us to shame, because God's love has been poured out into our hearts through the Holy Spirit, who has been given to us.

Lesson 22: John 3:17

For God did not send his Son into the world to condemn the world, but to save the world through Him.

Lesson 23: John 6:35

Then Jesus declared, "I am the bread of life. Whoever comes to me will never go hungry, and whoever believes in me will never be thirsty.

Lesson 24: Genesis 49:10

The scepter will not depart from Judah, nor the ruler's staff from between his feet, until He to whom it belongs shall come and the obedience of the nations shall be His.

Lesson 25: Genesis 50:20 or 50:24c

You intended to harm me, but God intended it for good to accomplish what is now being done, the saving of many lives.
