

KEY QUESTION

Why do we sing to God?

BIG TRUTH

God wants us to know Him.

Prayers of the Bible WBS Kids Lesson #1 Psalm 33. Psalm 138:1

Hook: Have you ever received an invitation to something? (A birthday party? Picnic? Playdate? Wedding?) How did it make you feel to be invited? Did you want to go? Did you go and have fun?

Book: In today's Bible story, we are going to look at a psalm. Do you know what a psalm is? A psalm is a poem or a song to God that we find in the Bible. The song we're learning about today is an invitation to all of us! Wow, an invitation for all of us! I'm excited! Are you excited? Let's see what this invitation is about.

Psalm 33, verses 1 through 3 is an invitation from God to sing, praise, make music, sing songs, and be joyful. Anytime! Anywhere! Let's see what this psalm says.

Sing for joy in the Lord, you who are right with Him.

It is right for the pure in heart to praise Him.

Give thanks to the Lord with harps.

Sing praises to Him with a harp of ten strings.

Sing to Him a new song.

Play well with loud sounds of joy.

Can you think of some reasons to sing to God and have joy? Here are some things I thought of:

God is our Creator. He made us and loves us

God is faithful. He keeps His Word, His promises.

God watches over us ALL THE TIME!

God helps us and is strong for us.

We can trust God. We can have joy and sing to Him anywhere, anytime because of who He is. He is always watching, listening, and inviting us to pay attention and know Him.

Look: Can you think of reasons why you might want to praise God or sing songs to Him? Tell us all! How does it make you feel to sing to God or Jesus? Do you always feel like praising or having joy in God? When you don't feel like praising God, what can you do to change how you feel? (Think about who God is, and how he will help you. He doesn't ever change. He always has His eye on you.)

Took: Prayer is talking to God, and we can do this with songs! We can do this with our voices and instruments. What is your favorite song to Sing to God?

Memory Verse: I will praise you Lord, with all my heart. Psalms 138:1a

Prayer: Let's sing our prayers and praise to God today. Let's sing your favorites! (Choose a song or two the kids know and sing to God.)
