

Prayers of the Bible WBS Kids Lesson #4 Exodus 15:1-21

Hook: Have you ever been in a scary situation that you thought you couldn't get out of? How did that feel? What did you do?

Book: Today we're going to hear about how God helped Moses and all his friends get out of a very scary situation. They were stuck and didn't think there was a way to escape. But God did something extra unbelievably amazing! God showed His mighty power and saved the people. When the people were safe, they prayed and sang and danced and thanked God for being a GREAT God who loves them and takes care of them.

Tell the story of crossing the Red Sea and the song of Moses and Miriam from Exodus 15:1-21 **OR** read the story *God Makes a Way* from *The Jesus Storybook Bible.*

Look: Put on some praise music! Have the kids wave scarves or just their arms, or play instruments as they dance around. As the kids dance, read the words of today's prayer (maybe more than once!) Remind the kids that celebrating God is an awesome way to pray and thank God for being SUPER AMAZING!
