

Hook: Can you think of a time when something that was important to you got broken? Maybe you spent a long time building a very special Lego building and someone smashed it to pieces? How did that make you feel? Did you think your Mom or Dad didn't care about you because they didn't protect your Lego building?

Book: Today in our Bible Story we get to read about Nehemiah, who was very sad that his people's city had been smashed to pieces when it was time for them to go home.

Tell the story of Nehemiah from Nehemiah 1:1-11 **OR** read Story 26 - *Nehemiah is Sad* in *The Beginner's Gospel Storybook Bible*

Look: Have leaders or helpers act out the story using fun props from the classroom (crown, tissues, blocks, cup for the cup bearer). You will need a person to play God, Nehemiah, and King Artaxerxes.

Took: God listens to us and He wants to help.
