

## Prayers of the Bible WBS Kids Lesson #18 Luke 2:25-38

Hook: Raise your hand if you have ever waited a really long time for something you wanted (maybe your birthday? Or Jesus' birthday?) How long did you wait? When the day finally came and your waiting was over, was it as awesome as you expected it to be?

Book: Well today, we're going to hear about 2 people who waited almost their WHOLE lives for Jesus our Savior to be born. Their names are Simeon and Anna. They spent most of their time with God, reading and praying in the temple. And even sometimes going without lunch so they had more time to think about God.

**Look:** (Have kids stay seated after the video ends)

Psalm 5 in the bible is a prayer to God. Verse 3b says:

"In the morning I pray to you.

I wait for you with Hope."

Simeon and Anna expected God to do something amazing that only God could do. They were SURE that God would send His son to save His people from sin! How did they know this? Because they spent so much time being close to God that they just knew He would keep His promise...even if they had to wait a L-O-N-G time. Let's praise God for always keeping His promises.

**Took:** The more we know God, the more we can trust Him. God keeps His promises.


