Jesus Rides Into Jerusalem John 12

COME:

We have been learning about so many amazing things Jesus did. He turned water into wine, he healed people, and he even brought a dead person back to life. For three years Jesus was teaching his friends and followers about God and doing amazing things. In our Bible story today, it's time for Jesus to go to the big city of Jerusalem. Let's see what happens when he gets there. I think we might even see a donkey!

SEE:

Read, "Jesus Rides into Jerusalem" from The Beginner's Gospel Story Book OR tell the kids the story of Jesus riding into Jerusalem from John 12 (see also Matthew 21:4-9 and Luke 19:35-40).

DO:

Some days I am so thankful for all the amazing things Jesus does for me that I just want to tell him how thankful I am for his goodness to me. That's what the people in our story did. They waved palm branches and shouted praise to Jesus. It was like a big parade. I have a great idea! Let's have our own parade! Have the kids line up behind you. Give them something to wave or just have them wave their hands. March around the room with the kids saying, "Hooray! Jesus is good and powerful! Jesus truly comes from God! Jesus is a friend to children and sinners!"

FOLLOW:

Jesus is truly God. He is the king God promised. Jesus deserves our praise and thankfulness. This week while you're at home, remember to follow Jesus by praising him with a thankful heart.
