BIG TRUTH

Jesus is good and powerful

COME:

Good morning! I'm so glad to see you. Does anyone remember our Bible story from last week? (Let the kids respond.) That's right. Last week we heard how Jesus died on the cross for our sins. That made me sad. How about you? Were you sad, too? Well today our Bible story is going to make you SO happy. You're going to be amazed. It is SO exciting! Let's get started reading our story!

SEE:

Read, "Jesus Lives!" from The Beginner's Gospel Story Bible OR tell the kids the story of Jesus rising from the dead in John 20:1-31.

DO:

Wow, Jesus is alive! Our Bible story today and last week made me feel all different kinds of feelings. Let's talk about those feelings and then we'll make faces to match our feelings. Let's try it.

SAD - Last week I was very sad that people were so mean to Jesus. They made fun of Jesus and then put him on the cross. Let me see everyone's SAD face.

AFRAID - On Sunday morning two women came to visit Jesus tomb but he was not there. An angel said, "Don't be afraid, Jesus is not here. Jesus has risen from the dead. Jesus is Alive! This time I want to see you AFRAID face.

WONDERING - The women went to tell Jesus' friends that Jesus was alive. His friends were not sure. Were the women telling the truth? How about a WONDERING face.

AMAZED - Jesus' friends wanted to see for themselves. They ran to the tomb. It was true. Jesus was not there Jesus is alive! Now let's see your AMAZED face.

You all did a great job. Jesus is good and powerful. Jesus is amazing. Jesus is alive!

FOLLOW:

Even though it was very hard for Jesus to give his life for us, he did it anyway. He died for us because he loves us so much. Here's a fun way we can follow Jesus this week. In every situation, think of the other person first. Maybe you want to watch TV but your friend wants to play a game. So choose to play a game with your friend. Maybe you want to go outside and play but your mom wants you to clean your room. So choose to clean your room.
