THE DAILY READING PLAN

The daily reading plan is a one-year cycle of readings covering the entire scriptures in one year and the Psalms are read in a 60-day cycle comprising a central part of your daily worship. Books of the Bible are predominately read sequentially rather than readings being organized thematically.

Each day is broken into morning readings and evening readings, this can be adapted to be read within one sitting if needed, but designed to begin and end your day in scripture.

PRAYERS FOR THE MONTH

Week #1: Nov. 1st - 7th

O God, our King, by the resurrection of your Son Jesus Christ on the first day of the week, you conquered sin, put death to flight, and gave us the hope of everlasting life: Redeem all our days by this victory; forgive our sins, banish our fears, make us bold to praise you and to do your will; and steel us to wait for the consummation of your kingdom on the last great day; through Jesus Christ our Lord. Amen.

Week #2: Nov. 8th - 14th

O God, the King eternal, whose light divides the day from the night and turns the shadow of death into the morning: Drive far from us all wrong desires, incline our hearts to keep your law, and guide our feet into the way of peace; that, having done your will with cheerfulness during the day, we may, when night comes, rejoice to give you thanks; through Jesus Christ our Lord. Amen.

Week #3: Nov. 15th - 21st

O God, the author of peace and lover of peace, to know you is eternal life and to serve you is perfect freedom: Defend us, your humble servants, in all assaults of our enemies; that we, surely trusting in your defense, may not fear the power of any adversaries, through the might of Jesus Christ our Lord. Amen.

Week #4: Nov. 22nd - 28th

O Lord, our heavenly Father, almighty and everlasting God, you have brought us safely to the beginning of this day: Defend us by your mighty power, that we may not fall into sin nor run into any danger; and that, guided by your Spirit, we may do what is righteous in your sight; through Jesus Christ our Lord. Amen.

OBSERVANCE OF CHURCH HOLIDAYS

1 - All Saints Day

A day set aside to memorialize the lives of those saints, known or unknown, that have come before us. The day offers an opportunity to remember the rich tradition of Jesus followers that inspire our faithfulness today.

30 - Day of Saint Andrew

It was Andrew who brought the boy with the loaves and fishes to Jesus for the feeding of the multitude. The tradition claims that he was crucified on an X-shaped cross. Andrew has been the patron saith of Scotland since the middle of the eighth century.
