THE DAILY READING PLAN

The daily reading plan is a one-year cycle of readings covering the entire scriptures in one year and the Psalms are read in a 60-day cycle comprising a central part of your daily worship. Books of the Bible are predominately read sequentially rather than readings being organized thematically.

Each day is broken into morning readings and evening readings, this can be adapted to be read within one sitting if needed, but designed to begin and end your day in scripture.

ENTERING THE ADVENT SEASON

Week #1: Dec. 1st - 5th - Theme: "Come, Lord Jesus"

- Day 1 - Genesis 1-2
- Day 2 - Isaiah 2
- Day 3 - Psalm 122
- Day 4 - Isaiah 11
- Day 5 - Examen

Week #2: Dec. 6th - 12th - Theme: "How long, O Lord?"

Week #3: Dec. 13th - 21st - Theme: "You will have joy!"

OBSERVANCE OF CHURCH HOLIDAYS

21 - Thomas the Apostle

A day to remember the Apostle who takes a central role in the gospel of John. Thomas's willingness to express his doubts and his faith is an example for us all.

25 - Christmas - The Nativity of our Lord Jesus Christ

One of the high marks of the Church calendar. Celebrates the incarnation of the Word of God in the birth of Jesus Christ.

26 - Stephen, Deacon and Martyr

A day to celebrate the first Christian martyr. His preaching caused a revolution in the attitude of some Jewish people toward the young church.

27 - John, Apostle and Evangelist

The author of 3 letters, the Gospel of John, and possibly the book of Revelation. A leader among the early Church.

28 - The Holy Innocents

A day of remembrance of the infanticide carried out by King Herod in an attempt to kill the "king of the Jews." A central theme of this day is to pray for God's mercy on all innocent victims, and for God to frustrate the plans of evil.
