

3. **The Stewardship of God's Economy (8:16-9:5).** How do you exercise discernment in your giving?

4. **The Principles of God's Economy (9:6-9).** What principles can you find in these verses? Why should we strive not to worry?

5. **The Source of our generosity in God's economy is God's abundance not our ability or provision (9:10-11).** Paul says two specific things are supplied by God. What are those things and what do they represent? What changes in us when we see our ability to access raw materials and create from them as a gift from God?

6. What is the appropriate response to God once we realize that our lives and all we have is a gift? What kinds of problems surface when we don't have this proper perspective?

7. The Impact of God's Economy (9:12-15). Paul tells us that the impact of God's economy addresses both the physical and the spiritual needs of others. What does it look like for you to meet both physical and spiritual needs through generosity?

8. Share with your group your next step to follow Jesus through radical generosity?
