- 1. Have you ever sensed that God wanted you to do something for Him that was so out of the box that you ran the other way?
- 2. Why do you think Jonah ran away from God? (vv. 1-3) What character traits of God can we fall back on to help us when we are tempted to run away?
- 3. Mark tells us the reason Jonah ran from God was due to his self-righteousness about his religion. How does the Gospel of Jesus Christ cut through religion and self-righteousness?

4. What does it say about God for Him to use a storm to turn people back to Him? (vv. 4-6)

5.	What does Jonah's confession in verse 9 tell us about Jonah starting to come around to God's will? (vv. 7-10)
6.	Discuss this quote: "When we fear God we don't have to fear anything else."
7.	What evidence do we see through these events that God changed the sailors? (vv. 11-16)
8.	Has God ever used unbelievers in your life to get your attention? How so?
9.	How does Jesus use the story of Jonah to explain his own ministry? (Luke 11: 29-32; Matthew 12:40)
10	Mark compared ancient Nineveh to the Bay Area. Can you identify a task that God might be designing for you so you can share the grace of God with people in need in your corner of the Bay Area?
