


CPC Community Group Questions May 9, 2021 Jonah 2

1. Read verses 1-6. Jonah finds himself in a pretty awful situation stuck in a giant fish. With no other real option, Jonah cries out to God for salvation. Can you think of one time your terrible situation pushed you to cry out to God?

2. We see in v.1 that during the moments of being thrown overboard and sinking Jonah prays for the first time in this story, and God listens and answers. What does this reveal about God's character?



6. Read verses 8-9. Jonah identified the worthless idol of religion in his life. When we become obsessed with anything besides the true and living God it becomes an idol. Idols can be revealed in the pursuit of significance, comfort, or pleasure. What do we do to turn aside from idols?

7. Go around the group and share what part of Jonah's story resonated most with you personally.
