

CPC Community Group Questions May 30, 2021 Genesis 12:1-20

1. What is one passage from the Bible you can think of that sounds simple, yet you have found yourself struggling with in the past?

- 2. Have you ever had an experience where God asked for you to do something costly to you?
  - a. If you did it, what were some ways God blessed you for doing it?
  - b. If you didn't, was there a blessing you missed out on?

3. Along with blessing Abram for obedience, the Lord promised to bless the whole world through him, what is one time God called you so that you could bless someone else?

4. While reading vv.4-5 Dan asked two questions, "Am I seeking God's will deliberately and passionately," and "am I making obedience too complicated?" What do you think of these questions in light of Abram's journey and your own?

5. In an act of faith Abram would make altars to God everywhere he went, lifting up God's name in return for God's promises. How can we use our blessings to give back to God? 6. In Egypt, Abram's lack of faith put him and his wife in a tough situation, Dan reflected on this by asking three questions: "What does faith mean to Sarai, what does faith mean to Abram, and what does faith mean to you?" How would you answer these three questions?

7. Just like Abram, God calls us to display obedient faith and then tests us to grow our faith, how is God growing your faith lately? How can you and your group pray about this?
