

CPC Community Group Questions June 20, 2021 Genesis 15

1. At the beginning of Chapter 15 we see Abram turning to God after he rejected a deal with the king of Sodom, because of this Abram asks God how he will keep his end of the deal. Have you ever acted on faith, only to wonder how God will come through for you?

2. In response to this, God reminds Abram once more of his promise and rewards his faith. What are some applications you can take from God's response to Abram?

- 3. Yet Abram asks God again how he can be sure, do you ever find your relationship with God flipping back and forth from faith to doubt?
 - a. If so, how do you handle those lapses of faith?
 - b. Just as God reminded Abram of His own faithfulness, we can remind each other of God's faithfulness today. What are some ways you can do that among each other?

4.	We see in v.9 onwards that God takes his promise one step further by making a unilateral covenant with Abram, why would he do this?
5.	As he closed his sermon Dan brought out three questions Abram asked here, and questions we often ask: "Lord, how can I know about you? Lord, How can I know about me? Lord, what are you doing?" a. Do any one of these questions stick out to you today? b. As we look back on the story of Abram and see how God answered these questions in his life, how does this make you feel?
6.	As you go back to your daily life this week, consider meditating on God's
	promises for you.
	a. If you have time as a group, read through each of the following passages together. 2 Pet. 1:4, Acts 1:8, Jhn. 4:13-14, Lev. 26:11-12 Psa. 34:17, Lam. 3:22-23.
	 Now try picking one of these passages and spending time in prayer this week praying this promise with God, allowing him to remind you of his faithfulness.
