

CPC Community Group Questions July 25, 2021 Genesis 20-21

1. In this section, we once more find Abraham doubting God, while God remains faithful. How does Abraham's consistent struggle to have faith in God make you feel?

2. As chapter 20 opens, we see Abraham acting in what he believes is justified fear. Can you think of a time you have justified your actions with fear?

3. Confronted with the dangerous situation before him, Abimelek is instead told in v. 6 that God kept him from sinning against him. What does this tell you about God?

4. Next, we turn to chapter 21 we see God's faithfulness once more proved as he gifts Abraham and Sarah their son, Isaac. What do you think Abraham and Sarah thought as they held their newborn son at that moment?

5. Following this, Kevin pointed out that in v. 9 Sarah has become so concerned with the gift (Isaac) that she has forgotten the giver (God). Likewise to Abraham, she acts out of her fears, but how does God act in this situation?

6. In v.22 Abilimelek again steps on the scene, as he sees God's faithful presence in Abraham's life. What are some ways God's faithfulness can be seen in your life?

7. Looking over these chapters together, and seeing God's continual delivery on his word, what are some ways we can apply this text today?
