- 1. When was the last time you were tested in some way, be it physically, mentally or in some other way?
 - a. Did this testing reveal something to you about yourself?
 - b. What are some things God's testing of Abraham revealed about him?

2. Can you think of an instance when someone prized a gift given to them, over the person giving it to them?

- 3. In the sermon, Mark said that God was removing the middle ground for Abraham; either he worshiped Him (the giver) or Isaac (the gift). What is one thing you treasure in your life? If you were asked to give it away, would you actually be able to?
 - a. What if you had to sacrifice it to do something God is calling you to do?

- 4. How can we correct our valuing of the things we have, and God who gives them to us?
 - a. What is one thing you could give up today, in order to do something God is calling you to do?

5. What are some areas you might fail in, if God were to test you today? What are some you'd pass in?

6. Read Genesis 22:14-19. In light of what had transpired God did exactly what he said he would, and provided a sacrifice in Isaac's place. Not only this, but he blessed Abraham and his lineage because of it, how does this make you feel about God's character?
