

CPC Community Group Questions August 15, 2021 Genesis 24:1-67

- 1. What are two or three things that stuck out to you from Dan's sermon?
- 2. One of the first things we see in this chapter is Abraham owning the promises of God. Take a moment to reflect on how long it has taken God working faithfully, to see Abraham fully trust him.
  - a. What were some of the things Abraham seemed slow or unwilling to trust God with?

- 3. Not only is he owning God's promise, but Abraham is now using God's promise to encourage others around him. Is this something you do as well?
  - a. If not, how do you think you could start this practice?
  - b. If you do, have you seen God work from your encouragement?

4. Just as finding a bride for Isaac was entrusted to this unnamed servant, how often do we actually entrust pivotal things in our life to God?

5. Along with this, Dan mentioned in his sermon that "Trusting God should never be a passive act", so how do we trust God actively instead?

6. We see in v. 15 that before the servant had even finished praying, God was fulfilling his prayer. What does this say about prayers, and our role in them?

- 7. What can we learn from both Rebekah's hospitality, and her decision to hurry back to her now betrothed?
  - a. What do you think motivated Rebekah to accept this rushed return?

8. Finally, how does this story speak to God's continuing faithfulness even beyond Abraham?
