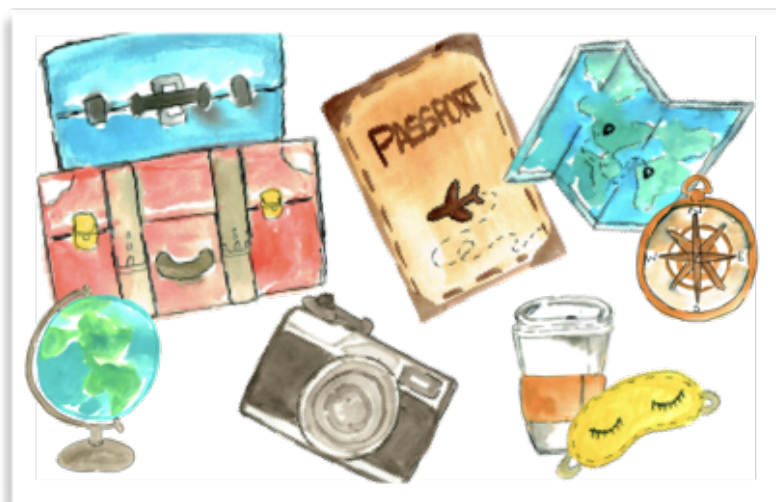


LET'S GO!
