Parent/Child Activity

Today the kids learned that God gave Peter an unusual dream to tell him something very important.

This week talk with your kids about how important it is to listen to what God tells them. They can hear a lot from God by reading the Bible and listening to God when they pray. Here are a few verses to read with your kids:

Proverbs 3:5

I wonder...

Introduction

I wonder why Jesus gave Peter such an unusual dream...

Ask the kids about dreams they have had. Tell them about one of your own (be sure that what you share is not scary for the kids).

Story

Read THE SHEET OF ANIMALS from The Complete Illustrated Children's Bible, Harvest House Publishers (page 562) or tell the story of Peter's Dream from **Acts 10**.

Get packed...

Activity

Make a Sheet of Animals.

Tape a large sheet of butcher paper to the wall at kid height. Have the kids draw all kinds of animals, reptiles and birds. Talk with the kids about Peter's dream as they draw. Give them suggestions about unusual animals to draw. i.e. kangaroos, eagles, snakes, tigers, elephants, gorillas, etc.
