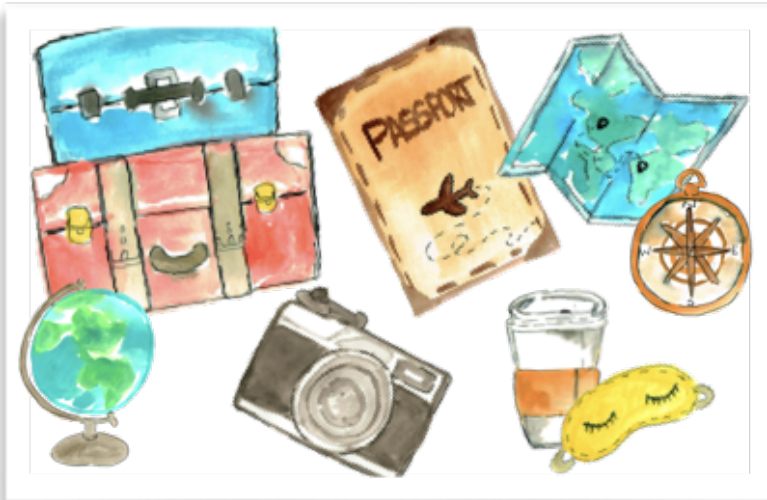


# LET'S GO!

### Share the journey... Parent/Child Activity

### Activity

Play a game of SAME-DIFFERENT

Choose two kids and have them stand side by side. Ask them to look at each other and think of one thing about them that is the same, and one thing about them that is different. Have the kids tell you what they come up with. Give all the kids a chance to have a turn. Remind the kids that God doesn't have favorites. God loves everyone!
