# Get packed... Activity

### Play a game of ESCAPE

Before class, prepare a paper chain with five links for each of the kids (make the links large enough to fit over the kid's hands). Slip an end of the paper chain around both of each kid's hands. Review the story using verses 6 and 7. Peter was sleeping between soldiers, bound with two chains, and the sentries stood guard at the entrance. Suddenly an angel of the Lord appeared, and a light shone in the cell. He struck Peter on the side and woke him up. "Quick, get up!" (Have the kids stand up). And the chains fell off Peter's wrists. (Let the kids tear the paper chains off their wrists.)
