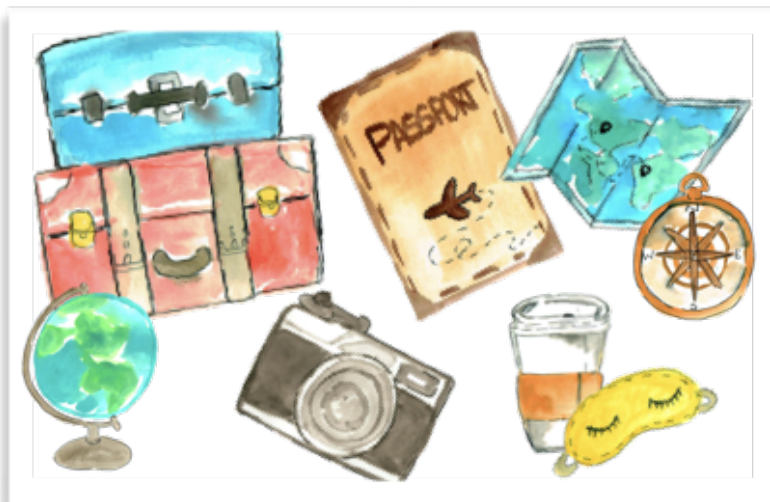


# LET'S GO!

Along the way...

### Share the journey... Parent/Child Activity

Today the kids learned that God sent Paul to help a slave girl. God loved the slave girl and wanted to help her,

This week remind your kids that God loves them very much, just like he loved the slave girl. Even though she was young, God cared about her and sent someone to help. Ask your kids if they are willing to care for people who need help. It could be as easy as being kind or sharing.

Pray with your kids. Encourage them to be joyful and brave.

### Introduction

I wonder why God wanted Paul to go to Macedonia... I think Paul and his friends wondered, too! But they did what God said and God used them to help a slave girl. Let's read our story.

## Where to...

### Story

Read HEALING A SLAVE GIRL from The Complete Illustrated Children's Bible, Harvest House Publishers (page 572). Or tell the story from **Acts 16:1-24**.

## Get packed...

### Activity

Sit in a circle with the kids holding a ball in your hands. Pass the ball to the person on your right and ask them to tell you a way they can help someone. When they are finished have them pass the ball to the next person and the repeat the process until everyone has had a turn. Help the kids come up with an answer if they are struggling.

## Let's go!

### Application

The slave girl was being mistreated by her owners. They had her tell people's fortune so they could make lots of money. God loved that slave girl and sent Paul to help her. Will you help someone when God asks you to?
