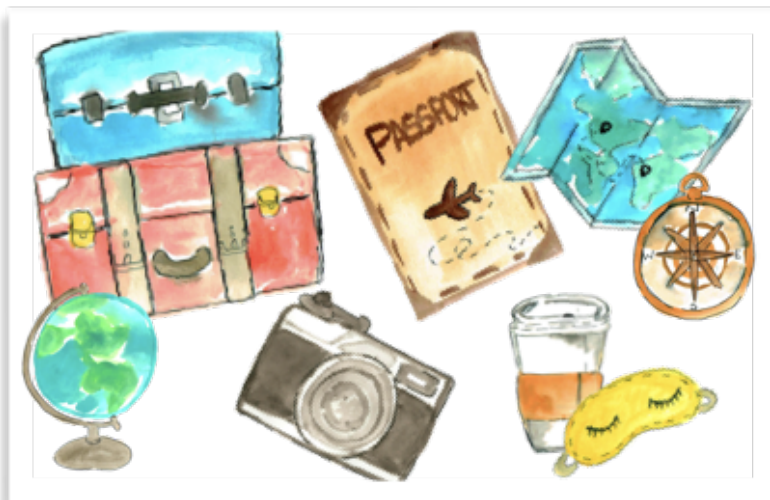


# LET'S GO!

Parent/Child Activity

## Get packed...

### Activity

Take the kids on a "journey" around the room, down the hall, or somewhere fun and safe. Remind the kids that God took Paul on an amazing journey so that Paul could tell people all over the world about Jesus. Along your "journey" stop every once in a while, and have the kids say (shout!) something good they know about God.
