- 5. Read verses 1-4. What is comforting about these verses to you personally? What is sobering about these verses to you personally? What can you apply to your life?
- 6. Read verses 5-12. Why do you think God doesn't give us knowledge of the specific time of the last days or Jesus' second coming?
- 7. What can you observe from this passage that needs to happen before Jesus' second coming?

- 8. Discuss this quote from Sinclair Ferguson: "The biblical response to the promises of God's coming kingdom is to always live for that kingdom now, recognize his reign now, be obedient now, fulfill your present responsibilities now"
- 9. Read verse 13. What does it look like for you to "go your way till the end"?
- 10. What are some good ways that your community group can be a source of encouragement to you to persevere while in exile?
