

## **LESSON 3**

## **ISAIAH 6**

٦.	How did Isaiah's song of the vineyard in Ch. 5 speak to your heart, prompting you to prune
	your hearts' desires this week?

2. Pray and then slowly read through **Isaiah 6**, as Isaiah is brought into the presence of the glory of his Enthroned King. Look back at **2 Chronicles 26:21-23** and **27:1-9** to read about the transfer of leadership between Judah's kings Uzziah and Jotham. As you consider what this meant for Judah, what might Isaiah's emotional state have been when he entered into this experience in the throne room of the Lord?

- 3. Review the throne room scene in Isaiah 6:1-4.
  - a) Who does Isaiah see in **V1** and describe His divine attributes? See **John 12:41** also.

NOTE: Questions are based on NIV 2011 Translation

	b) Describe the heavenly beings, or seraphim, in <b>Isaiah 6:2-4</b> , including their posture and what they're doing.
	c) Who or what have you highly exalted in your life? Give space to the Lord now to give you a fresh conviction.
4.	In <b>V5</b> , what is Isaiah's response to the Lord on His throne, and why do you think he reacted this way? <i>Note: consider the messages we've already studied in <b>Isaiah 1-5</b>.</i>
5.	a) What happens at the altar of the Lord in <b>V6-7</b> ?
	b) <u>Challenge:</u> Why do you think a burning coal was used to cleanse or purify Isaiah's mouth? Refer to <b>Numbers 16:46</b> and <b>Malachi 3:3</b> for more insight.
6.	See <b>Isaiah 6:8</b> . What does the Lord ask after Isaiah is purified and what is Isaiah's answer?

7. The Lord outlines Isaiah's assignment (or commission) in **V9-12**. Describe Isaiah's mission in your own words. What is your reaction to Isaiah's assignment?

- 8. We read in **V13** that there's still hope for God's people:
  - What are hopeful phrases in this verse?
  - Who do you think the holy seed or stump is? Cite other Scripture if you can.
- 9. Reflecting on who God is: **King / Enthroned One (Yoshev)**

Just as Judah lost it's king, Isaiah sees **Yoshev**, the eternally **Enthroned One**, seated in majesty and power. John, in **Revelation 4:2-3**, wrote "At once I was in the Spirit, and there before me was a throne in heaven, with someone sitting on it. And the one who sat there had the appearance of jasper and ruby. A rainbow that shone like an emerald encircled the throne." When we come before our **Enthroned King** in all His glory and majesty, we will fall down in worship. For who can stand before the Lord our God? Write a prayer of confession, worship, and/or recommitment as your heart is led.
