*Consider Yourself Sent*

***Apprentices to Jesus should consider themselves sent to share the gospel of Jesus Christ.***

1. Discuss a time when you saw the authority and power of Jesus at work in the community.
2. Replication of Jesus' Ministry (vv. 6b-13)
  - A. What challenges you personally about the instructions Jesus gives the twelve?
  - B. How do you understand repentance as part of the gospel message?
  - C. What does Jesus' emphasis on casting out demons and healings tell us about the heart of God and how we are to do ministry?
3. The Reaction to Jesus' Ministry (vv.14-29)
  - A. Why do you think there is such a negative reaction to Jesus' ministry in the world?
  - B. What can you apply from the life and death of John the Baptist as you consider yourself sent?
4. The Returns on Jesus' Ministry (v. 30)
  - A. Why is it important to gather and share stories of what God is doing?

- B. Spend a few minutes in your group swapping stories about what God is doing?
5. What might need to change in your life for you to more fully embrace the phrase, “consider yourself sent”?
