## Apprentices to Jesus should consider themselves sent to share the gospel of Jesus Christ.

- 1. Discuss a time when you saw the authority and power of Jesus at work in the community.
- 2. Replication of Jesus' Ministry (vv. 6b-13)
  - A. What challenges you personally about the instructions Jesus gives the twelve?
  - B. How do you understand repentance as part of the gospel message?
  - C. What does Jesus' emphasis on casting out demons and healings tell us about the heart of God and how we are to do ministry?
- 3. The Reaction to Jesus' Ministry (vv.14-29)
  - A. Why do you think there is such a negative reaction to Jesus' ministry in the world?
  - B. What can you apply from the life and death of John the Baptist as you consider yourself sent?
- 4. The Returns on Jesus' Ministry (v. 30)
  - A. Why is it important to gather and share stories of what God is doing?

- B. Spend a few minutes in your group swapping stories about what God is doing?
- 5. What might need to change in your life for you to more fully embrace the phrase, "consider yourself sent"?
