Read Mark 8:22-26

1. Share with your group about a person in your life that was especially instrumental in bringing you into the presence of Jesus?
2. How would you describe your spiritual clarity these days?
3. What do you think the disciples learned as they watched Jesus touch, lead, and heal the blind man?
4. What dynamics are at work for us to actually be led by Jesus? What is most challenging to you personally about being led by Jesus?
5. Discuss the unusual “two-touch” healing of this miracle. What does it tell us about how God might work in our lives? What does it look like to put yourself in places where you receive multiple touches from Jesus?
6. Consider these four principles Dan shared at the end of his sermon. Which one resonates most with you? Why?
 - A. Never assume that because we see some things clearly, we see all things clearly.
 - B. Be patient with others who do not see clearly what we think they should see clearly.

- C. Be encouraged that your mission is to bring people to Jesus so he can lead people to see clearly.
 - D. There is no seeing clearly without seeing the cross of Christ.
7. Share an area of your life where you could use more spiritual clarity from Jesus. Pray for each other in your group.
