- 1. Read Mark 10: 32-34. How has your response to the symbol of the cross changed over the years?
- 2. Read Mark 10: 35-41. In response to the disciples' brazen request, "We want you to do for us whatever we ask..." Why is this the wrong way to approach Jesus?
- 3. What do the meanings of the words "cup" and "baptism" reveal about Jesus' invitation to join him in His work?
- 4. What might it look like to reorganize our lives around self-sacrifice? Discuss how we even begin to move in that direction?
- 5. Read Mark 10: 42-44. In what ways can we contrast earthly authority/leadership with Jesus' authority/leadership?
- 6. How do the words "servant" and "slave" help us understand the way of Jesus?
- 7. Read Mark 10: 45. Kevin's big idea is, "The death of Jesus makes the difference for eternity." Jesus uses the words "Ransom" and "for many". Why are these words important?
- 8. Discuss the Tim Keller quote: "All life changing love is a substitutionary sacrifice."
