Mark 12:35-44

1. The concept of resume versus eulogy virtues was explored at the beginning of Kevin's sermon. How did this resonate with you?
2. The teachers of the law in verses 38-40 were exhorted to be careful due to their need for recognition and power. What position or responsibilities do you have that you can easily be misused for power and prestige?
3. Kevin encouraged the church to "live authentically." What does that look like for you?
4. It was mentioned in the sermon about "being the same person in every area of your life." (ex: church, home, work, grocery store, etc.) What steps and/or precautions can you take to develop your character? How can this group support you and be praying for you in this?
5. One of the categories Kevin summed up in his sermon was that "truth matters." He went on to explain what truth is, "that which matches reality." How would you "build your life in reality?"
6. It was referenced in the second bullet point of the sermon, in terms of the ups and downs of our character-building to "just do the next right thing." How does this apply to your life?
7. The third and final summary of the passage was based on "simplicity matters." This point poses the question of what holds us back from living simply?. Kevin raised our awareness to "What are you attached to?" How would you answer this question?
